REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS
Mural Restoration Project
Depot Plaza

The City of Barnesville invites professional artists experienced with creating or restoring murals, art service providers, or art conservators to submit a proposal for the Depot Plaza Mural Restoration Project.

Background

Located on the rear of the building located at 101 Main Street. The mural was originally created by muralist Shannon Lake. The mural is painted on a two story brick building which overlooks the City of Barnesville Depot Plaza.



Project Description

Originally painted in 2002 by Shannon Lake the mural is currently in poor condition due to the effects of age and environmental wear. Because the condition is poor, some areas of the mural will require repainting while other areas may require conservation treatment. Some masonry repairs to wall may be required. The mural will be repainted, maintaining the style, color and graphic quality of the original mural as closely as possible.

The proposal should include the following:

1. Surface preparation (including priming and repair) of the brick wall as needed
2. Painting of the mural with high quality acrylic paint.
3. Repair to masonry as necessary.
4. Graffiti and UV coating.

All expected labor, materials and equipment costs should be included in the Project Outline Budget. General Liability Insurance and Workman's Compensation are required for the project.

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Eligibility

The City of Barnesville requests a statement of qualifications detailing previous experience in mural painting or mural restoration work. Submission Requirements

In order to be considered, the following must be submitted to the City of Barnesville, 109 Forsyth Street, Barnesville, GA 30204 by 2:00 p.m., May 23, 2016:

1. Letter of Qualifications
2. Three Professional References (1 typed page)
3. Narrative Proposal detailing methods, equipment, materials and timeline
4. Budget

Selection Process

The City of Barnesville will review all proposals before submitting a recommendation to the City Council on June 6, 2016. The City of Barnesville reserves the right to reject any or all responses to the RFP, to advertise for new RFP responses, or to accept any RFP response deemed to be in the best interest of the project. The RFP does not commit the City to pay for any costs incurred in the submission of a response to this RFP or for any costs incurred prior to the execution of a final contract.
