SOLID WASTE What you need to know...

Recycling Center Closure

The City of Barnesville Recycling Center will permanently close on June 1, 2022. City of Barnesville residents can take items to the Lamar County Cedar Grove Landfill the 1st Saturday of each quarter at no charge. Proof of residency is required.

Yard Trimmings & Debris Collection

- 1. Limit of 3 cubic yards per week.
- 2. Prohibited items: dirt, rocks, cinder blocks, bricks, concrete, gravel or sand.
- 3. Service is for residents only and is not meant to relieve commercial operations or contractors of their responsibility of debris removal.





Junk Collection

- 1. Shall not exceed 100 lbs per week.
- 2. Resident and/or contractor are responsible for removal of materials from construction/remodeling projects.
- 3. The City is not responsible for collection of junk and household items generated as a result of cleaning out a rental unit. Property owners are responsible for removal.
- 4. Prohibited items: tires, building materials, dirt, concrete, bricks, rock, carpet, duct pipes, insulation, plaster roofing and drywall.

Garbage and Recycling

- The City of Barnesville Garbage and Recycling Program is a One-Cart System. All refuse both recyclable and non-recyclable, will be disposed of in one garbage cart.
- 2. Be sure to have your cart out for collection by 5 a.m. on your scheduled service day. Routes may begin as early as 6:00 a.m.
- 3. Carts must be placed on the curb with the lid opening pointing to the street, no more than 3' from the curb, and at least 4' from any fixed object or parked vehicle and in a manner to prevent a traffic hazard.
- 4. All garbage shall be bagged and placed inside the cart.
- 5. Batteries, Hot Ash or Coals, Flammable or Hazardous Materials, Paint & Tires will not be collected.
